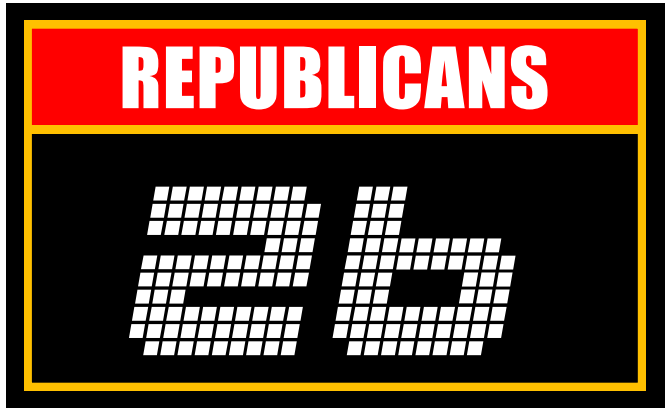
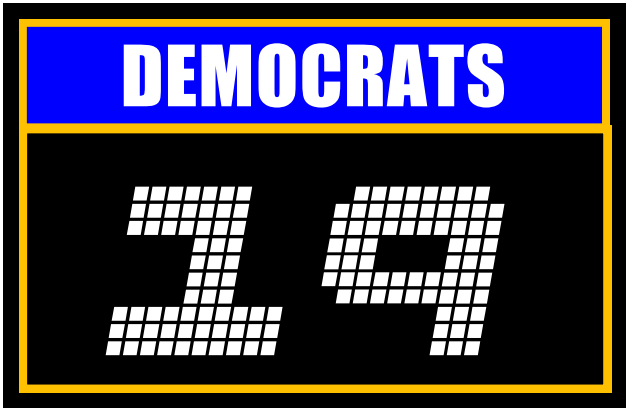

"Base" is the highest business support category; "Swing" is medium; "Occasional" is low.</p> <p> - 10 Opportunity races for free-market advocates; candidates can win with support.</p> <p>NC Partisan Index - Civitas Institute's district partisan advantage greater/less than statewide average.</p> <p>Davis Trends Partisan +/- Net - Late Breaking Trends and NC Partisan Index combined = Net partisan advantage</p>
